



The prevention of disease agents from entering or leaving places where they can pose a risk to animals, humans, or the safety and quality of food.





THREATS TO BIOSECURITY

Biosecurity risks can come from the **illegal importation** of animals that

- Do not receive proper vet care
- Do not undergo quarantine
- Are smuggled into the country



BIOSECURITY RISKS: DOMESTICS

Smuggled dogs

Are not treated humanely

 Can carry diseases like distemper and parvovirus



BIOSECURITY RISKS: LIVESTOCK

Smuggled farm animals can bring **exotic diseases**, like

- Avian Influenza
- Newcastle Disease
- Foot and Mouth Disease




These can


- Harm local livestock

Diseases in trafficked wildlife can spread to

Local wildlife populations
