STATE OF THE PARTY

This is the HUMANE termination of an animal's life in order to alleviate pain and suffering.

What does it entail?

The Greek equivalent of the word euthanasia literally translates to "good death". As such, the veterinarian usually administers the appropriate dose of anaesthetic drug(s) that will allow the animal to go into a deep, neverending sleep.

When might euthanasia be considered?

- 1. Poor quality of life
- 2. Terminal illness
- 3. Critical injury
- 4. Exhaustion of all financial resources needed to treat or care for the animal.
- 5. Difficult or unmanageable behaviour, e.g. aggression.
- Overpopulation they can negatively impact the ecosystem, etc.
